- Showroom Floor. Frac Pump truck. “Fracking” is the process whereby millions of gallons of water are injected into natural gas wells.
- Booth 3. EnCana will demonstrate sound blankets, which are a new technology that minimizes the noise from drilling rigs near neighborhoods.
- Booth 4. Devon Energy is bringing high-tech drill bits and samples of the Barnett Shale core to show the public and also will have examples of water purification technology on hand.
